SYNOPSIS

This joint symposium brings together two traditions – semiotics and the semiosis of life (IUK, Bishkek) and social sciences and arts across Eurasia (The 7th ESSA, Kut Bilim, Turkey) – into a single dialogue. The conference explores life as a semiotic system – a process of producing, transmitting, and interpreting signs – while also addressing social transformations, education, pedagogy, and culture as sign-based human practices. Scholars from philosophy, linguistics, literature, biology, physics, education, law, psychology, sociology, political science, and the arts will discuss both theoretical and practical perspectives.

METHODOLOGICAL APPROACHES

1. **Semantic-Categorial Approach:** Life analyzed through ontologies, models, and categorial structures.
2. **Semiotic-Phenomenological Approach:** Life understood as generating meanings and experiencing sign relations.

3. **Education and Transformation:** Education for the future labor market, digital pedagogy, AI for sustainable learning.
4. **Social Sciences and Arts:** Gender and inequality, law and governance, psychology and society, arts and cultural transformations.

- Where is the boundary between life as an “information system” and life as an “experience”?
- What is a “semiotic type of life”—a model, a metaphor, or an ontological reality?
- What kind of education is needed for the future labor market?
- What is the role of technologies in improving the quality of life?

- **Round Tables:** Discussions between representatives of the natural sciences and the humanities.
- **Semiosis Laboratories:** Collaborative work on the concept of the “semiotic type of life.”

- **Workshops and Master Classes:** Teaching and Methodology - innovative practices in teaching and methodology, with a focus on education, pedagogy, and instructional techniques.
- **Poster Presentation:** Paintings, visual explorations, and semiotic interpretations of cultural artifacts, emphasizing how artistic representations convey symbolic and cultural meanings.
- **Exhibition:** Authentic artifacts and handmade traditional crafts, including shyrdak, oimo, saima, and other forms of embroidery, presented as material embodiments of Kyrgyz heritage.
- **Art Therapy (Psychological Sessions):** Art therapy techniques and psychological approaches to promote well-being, creativity, and self-expression, emphasizing the intersection of psychology, visual arts, and semiotics in educational contexts.

EXPECTED OUTCOMES

- Development of a conceptual map of terms and models for the semiotic type of life.
- Compilation of an interdisciplinary text corpus illustrating life as a sign process.
- Establishment of a foundation for further collaborative research, including publications and grants.
- Improvement of the quality of education through shared practices and methodologies.

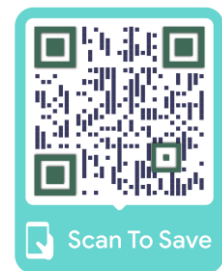
